

COURSE DESCRIPTION AND MAPS	Approximately 1,800m of ascending, 4,155m of descending, and 42 Km approximate distance Approximate total GC time: 30mins+ for fast riders, 60mins+ for average riders, 120-180mins for slower riders Approximate amount of climbing: One mechanical uplift to the start of Liaison Stage 1 and 5. All Liaison Stages are to be pedalled.  Terrain Type: Tight and technical forested singletrack, wet roots and rocks, rain ruts, and some stream crossing.
	Course maps will be posted 28 Nov 2018 after the Welcome/Practice Briefing, on our Website and Facebook page.
SEEDING and RACE ORDER	The current standing positions of the top 10 riders of each categories from the Asian Enduro Series will be used as "Qualification Seeding Order", the rest of the riders will be placed after that.  The qualification results will be used to set rider's start times and waves start.  *Riders who did not purchase the uplift package must go to SS5 by themselves by the qualification start time.
START LISTS	All riders will have allocated start time on SS1 and SS5. The start intervals is 30 seconds.
RESULT	End of day results posted at ICE office, Khum Phucome Hotel.



CLAIMS/PROTEST	All protests should be addressed to the ICE Office, Khum Phucome in person, within 15 minutes of provisional results posted. All protests must accompany a deposit amount of 2000 baht, protester will only get the deposit back if the protesting result turn in favour of the protesters. ICE Director: Nawaphansa Yugala
PARTIES/SOCIAL	Sunday 2, 1500-1900 Afternoon snack served at the ICE Festival Venue  *Alcohol will be available to purchase.
RACE RULE	Please refer to the the ICE Rule Book.
WATER STATIONS	Water stations will be located on various Liaison Stages, and elsewhere around the course where it is felt to be beneficial.  These will be marked on a map at the Race Office.  Riders are allowed to buy food and drink at the local shop where available but it is advisable to prepare your own.
TECH SUPPORT	Team / personal mechanics cannot fix rider's bikes during the race day. The riders must be ready to look after themselves out there. From 29 Nov there will be neutral mechanics (by Buu Bike) on hand and some spares that can be purchased if they are stuck (like inner tubes). All riders should bring their own specific spare parts, e.g. dropout hangers, bearing etc.



FIRST AID /EMERGENCY RESPONSE	During event –  ICE Office 095-687-9454  Please look out for each other and alert the next marshal you pass of any accident you have seen on course.  Outside of these times –  In the event of an emergency when riding, please dial 0617962627 for EMS. We recommend that you download a grid reference/gps app to your phone and carry a map to make locating you easier and faster.
